Originating from over 30 different nations, many from countries throughout Asia, our people truly are "an inheritance of nations." Our Mission at KIBC is simple, biblical, and crucial. God has told us to "Go and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). Everyday thousands of people encounter thousands of others along the sidewalks, in buses, and on trains. Most of these individuals pass by each other unnoticed and untouched and even more so during the pandemic. The drive for personal safety encourages us to withdraw. For many people, any sense of purpose is often lost in the crowd.

Over 90% of Hong Kongers, by their own admission, claim to have no relationship with Jesus. Many have NEVER heard a clear presentation of the Gospel in a way they can understand. Most have no Christian friend. Statistics suggest that in Kowloon there are about 980,000 English-speaking individuals who are lost, without Christ. Can you see why we are on an important mission? Why we "run with faith to win the prize" of sharing Jesus with a lost and broken world?

In all this lostness, Kowloon International Baptist Church seeks to share God's love with them. God has called us to reach out and share the message of hope with every individual, child, youth, university student, young professional, adult, family, and grandparents with the "good news" of salvation in Jesus. Our friends, family, co-workers, and acquaintances need to hear about Jesus.

The mission of reaching people for Jesus has led KIBC to embrace a bold plan of rebuilding our facility. It is not about the building; it is about the people. We desire to provide room for more people to come and experience the transforming power of the "Church." That calling, that mission, that vision is still as important as ever! Nothing has changed our mission. Events around us continue to remind us of the urgency of sharing God's love. We have an open door and we will be found "a good servant and faithful" to the mission, the calling, the cause, the challenge!

To make room for more people we responded in 2017 with the Open Campaign to position ourselves for a harvest of souls. We feel compelled to move forward to build a place where lost individuals will hear God's Word and choose to follow Him. It's always been about people.

Second, replace an aging facility. Our building has exhausted its lifespan.

Third, was the challenge of providing the financial resources to pay for the rebuild. At 245 million HKD's we knew it would require heroic sacrificial generosity. Our first Open Campaign was our first wave in providing funding. Those gifts made a grand statement that we are committed to reaching people for Jesus. Now we embark on our Next Chapter of Open.

Even though this is a season of great uncertainty, it doesn't surprise our God. In fact, from a spiritual perspective, it is during times of great change and challenge that people's self-sufficiency is broken, and they are awakened to their need for something more, something eternal, something that might be found in a relationship with Jesus. Our presence in this place, through our new building, will position us for a great harvest. Yes, our mission and building are as relevant as ever. Let's eagerly move forward in **Open: Next Chapter** and see the dream become a reality.

I want to encourage you to be open, informed, and engaged in this next chapter of Open. As I have said before this is about **investing the next**3 years with the next 50 in mind. Let's be a church a people – that's open to be ALL IN!

Current Building Challenges

- Existing building is nearly 55 years old and near the end of its design life.
- Incidents of failing pieces of concrete, dilapidation, leaking roof, electrical failure and basement flooding are more commonplace.
- No wheelchair/barrier free access into the church.
- No passenger elevator.
- Insufficient classrooms to meet ministry needs, requiring rental space outside church.
- Inadequate number of toilets; handicap toilets.
- · Inadequate space for church offices.
- Auditorium: insufficient seating; poor acoustics, audio, and video capability.
- Easy penetration of traffic noise from Junction Road.
- Basement has temporary classrooms with poor facilities, seating, and acoustics.
- No fellowship space available.
- Basement is in bad condition because of humidity and water seepage issues.
- Limited central air-conditioning and no heating provision.
- No large kitchen, no drink dispensers, no water fountains.
- Numerous issues with children' areas.

Our current building has served its life span and limits ministry to every generation! Our calling to be a durable, permanent, accessible church for future generations compels us to respond in building a new ministry tool – for us, for others, for everyone – to know Jesus!

New Building Solutions

- Welcomes everyone with a beautifully stunning building that will stand
 out as a witness to Jesus as the true path to heaven, to salvation, to hope,
 to purpose.
- Expands ministry opportunities by providing triple the floor area.
- Creates room for more people by building 8 stories, including basement.
- Inspires worship with a modern multifunction sanctuary design with seating for over 460 per service.
- Builds connection and friendships with a dedicated multi-purpose hall for fellowship and recreation.
- Improves accessibility with a fire-rated passenger lift to all floors.
- Allows barrier free access with a wheelchair ramp and handicap toilets.
- Allows safe bus transfer for kindergarten children from inside the basement allowing protection from traffic and weather.
- · Provides adequate toilets on six floors.
- Provides centralized air-conditioning and heating to all parts of the building.
- Provides 8 basement car park spaces that can be multi-purpose space.
- Provides an open office plan, with 8 individual offices for staff, all on one floor.
