Observation

Each person sacrificed something to see the project move forward.

Not all of us can give the same amount, but we can all show the same sacrificial spirit. Sometime we might feel like our contribution does not make a difference. Nehemiah and the people were able to complete the rebuilding of the walls in 52 days. It took a huge sacrifice of everyone involved. We all can make a difference, because we all can make a sacrifice.

Application
